Who are we?

BILD Association of Certified Training is a new charity, set up to certify training services that include a restrictive intervention. We are licenced by the Restraint Reduction Network to certify services as complying with the Restraint Reduction Network Training Standards 2019.

What do you need to know about certification?

Commissioning requirements and inspection frameworks are changing. NHS commissioned services and the Care Quality Commission **will require certification of training services from April 2020.**

Certification of training against the Restraint Reduction Network Training Standards 2019 must also be accredited by the United Kingdom Accreditation Service (UKAS) as complying with the ISO certification standards to ensure impartiality, credibility and integrity. We are currently working towards accreditation with UKAS and expect that process to be completed in September 2019.

We already have 70 organisations currently working towards certification against the Restraint Reduction Network Training Standards 2019. These include in-house training (eg within an NHS Trust) and commercial training providers. The first training organisations will be certified in Autumn 2019.

The certification process takes approximately one year to complete, in light of this we are encouraging all training providers to start the process of certification in early 2019, ahead of certified training services becoming a requirement from April 2020.
