A *New Story* is emerging across Canada around the use of individualised approaches and support for people with a learning disability. Much of this work has involved strengthening of social networks. This event will give an overview of developments in Canada relating to the values and principles of self directed support; the social networks for people with learning disabilities and their families; building capacity for collaboration and innovation. Delegates will have an opportunity to consider the importance of strengthening people with learning disabilities and their families in order that they can play a leading role in the development of self directed support.
