### General Approach to Teaching Physical Interventions

The training focuses heavily on preventative strategies to avoid the application of physical intervention. Staff are made aware of the risk factors associated to physical intervention we also expose a number of safety factors to adhere to in the training.

We implement stringent testing procedures to ensure safe practice and hold regular refresher courses.

We have risk assessment protocols both for training and practice and ensure candidates have a clear understanding of how to support a young person after physical intervention has taken place.
