<b>General Approach to Teaching Physical Interventions</b>	
Physical interventions are taught as part of a programme rooted in understanding and working with service users whose behaviour may challenge us. It emphasises our duty to meet their needs and keep them safe. The legal context and relevant guidance is examined and there is training in developing and using primary and secondary intervention strategies which meet individuals' needs. Physical interventions are always a last resort. They are taught where a clear rationale has been developed and only those techniques which directly relate to behaviour are taught within any commissioning organisation.
