Making Positive Behaviour Support more inclusive

Award for Excellence in Inclusive Practice in Positive Behaviour Support

This year we are looking for nominations for excellence in inclusive practice in PBS, which means doing PBS with the person and those close to them rather than to them. Nominations are welcome from all sectors and from all populations and age ranges. This could include people with learning disabilities, autistic people, and people living with dementia, people who have mental health conditions, people that use forensic services or mainstream schools.

The interventions may be a single case, a service-wide intervention, or a whole organisational approach (or part of) which demonstrates the use of a particularly inclusive way of implementing PBS. The nominee may have worked closely alongside the person themselves and the key people in their lives, including families and support staff to implement PBS, or developed person centred and inclusive systems and strategies that really support involvement.

There will be one winner (no runners-up) who will be announced at the BILD PBS International conference in May 2020.

Criteria

The outcome must be improved quality of life (ie. not just reduction in behaviour which challenges)

The application must be consistent with:

- **The Gore definition**
- **MacDonald four composites**
- **Key messages of PBS document**

- How it was evaluated
- Outcomes
