The International Journal of Positive Behavioural Support Early Career Researcher Award is given annually to a researcher who has carried out high-quality applied research on Positive Behavioural Support and/or Challenging Behaviour.

Researchers should be recent (within the past two years) Masters Degree graduates, PhD students, recently completed PhD students (within the past two years), or practitioners who have fewer than five research publications in total and have published (including in press) peer reviewed research papers in 2019 or 2020.

Nominations for the award must be completed by the research thesis supervisor or a research collaborator using the nomination form provided. E-copies (in PDF format) of the publication or research thesis (chapter of PhD thesis, not the whole thesis) of the researcher reporting the high quality research study must be submitted with the nomination.

The deadline for submissions is 13 March 2020. Please email to conferences@bild.org.uk

The research publication/thesis and nomination form will be reviewed by the Editors, with the award announced at the BILD PBS International Conference in May 2020.
