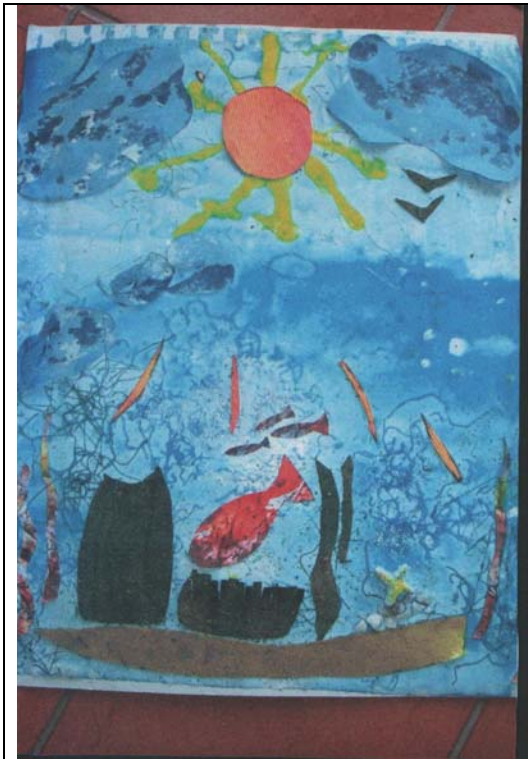


Multisensory Art Ideas



Multisensory mural

Clouds are made from blue paper with white soapy paint (not well seen on the photo)

Corrugated card for sun

Yoghurt painting – fish

Green paint on hessian for weeds

Sand glued onto yellow paper for sand



Multisensory Mural

Bark for tree

Paper and material for flowers and cat. Scent can be put on cotton wool balls and wrapped in material for the centre of the flowers



Ice cube painting

Use powdered paint
Make up icy poles of plain ice to paint with. Extend and thicken the handle of the icy pole stick to make it easier to hold

	<p>Multisensory Mural</p> <p>Background to the tree is hessian</p> <p>Mix green paint and pine needles into pva glue and paint onto the hessian tree shape</p> <p>Stars are cinnamon stars</p> <p>Holly leaves have green paint and scented cotton wool inserted in small red drawstring bags</p>



Outdoor Mural

Plaster fish and rocks have been screwed onto a textured background



Cutters, stampers and wax crayons can be made easier to hold by using dowel to make large handles

Making a T shaped bar can be easier for some people to hold than a vertical handle
