We will run the project.

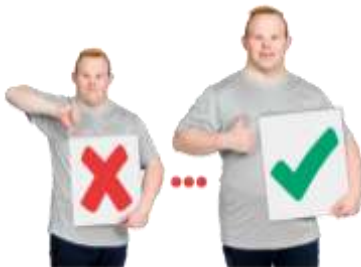
We have staff with the right skills and experience.

3. Train all of the co-trainers to run the training.



4. Train staff in the partner organisations.



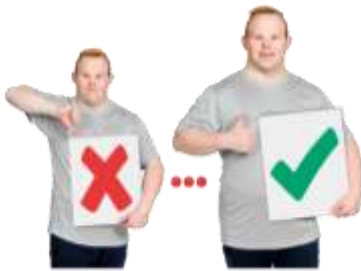
Experts by experience will be in every stage of the project.

Half of the people in the workshops to develop the training will be experts by experience.

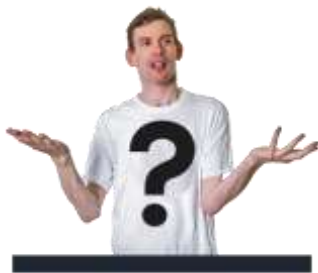


We will ask all our partners to give us the training they already.

We will then work together to make the best training we can.



We will test our training and make changes if needed.



How we will do it?



We will deliver our training trial in the North West and West Midlands.



We will train people how to co-deliver training



We will use eLearning and other learning people can do by themselves.



There will always be some face to face training for each course.

All face to face training will be run by an expert by experience and a professional.



We will work with Open Storytellers to make 30 videos of people telling their stories.



There will be different tier 1 training for learning disability and autism



Tier 2 training will cover both but make sure people understand the different needs of the two groups.



We will deliver tier 1 training to about 3150 staff.

We will deliver tier 2 training to about 2265 staff.

When we will do it?



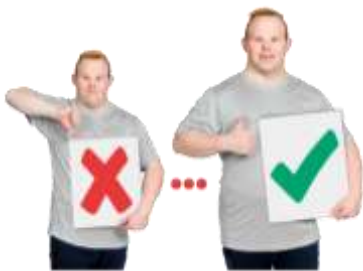
Due to Covid 19 we are happy to be flexible.
