The evolving world of PBS: moving forward together

Call for Video Poster Submissions

This year we would like to invite conference participants to submit Video Posters to communicate inclusive PBS in practice. We're not looking for research, but accounts of what people are doing to put the principles and practices of PBS into action in ways that include the people we support, families and support staff, to inspire the interest of conference participants and reflect the reality of current challenges.

What's a Video Poster?

A video poster is a short (max 4 min) video describing good practice and learning which will replace the traditional wall posters at this year's conference.

Video posters will cover the points below to describe inclusive PBS practice in your organisation, team or a particular project.

- What you did & why?
- What happened as a result?
- What factors were important?
- Any advice or tips for other people who want to use this way of working

The selected videos will be linked in the electronic conference proceedings and will also be displayed during the conference and to the public via social media. Guidelines for general audience viewing apply.

Video Poster Criteria

Your video poster can be as simple or elaborate as you wish but it must:

- Have been filmed in the last 6-12 months
- Be no longer than 4 minutes
- Be submitted in MP4 format (H.264) with a minimum resolution of 720p (not over 1080p).
- Include a slide at the beginning of the video with the title, authors and affiliation, and slide with credits/references at the end.
- NOT have any commercial pitch
- Have clear copyright of the audio and visual content. (NB: The copyright should be released to the conference.)

How to submit:

Step one: The submission of the videos will be via [wetransfer](https://www.wetransfer.com) to communications@bild.org.uk. The deadline for submitting is **4pm Friday 3rd September 2021**

Each video submission must be accompanied by a one-page description which includes:

- title, authors, and affiliation
- a brief description of the content,
- confirmation of copyright, and

- contact information

Step two: The Conference Team will view all videos and select those to be shared at the conference and on-line. Decisions will be communicated by Monday 13th September.
