Your associate responsibilities

- In your role as PBS Associate, you will be working in the settings you have experience in – whether health and social care or education.
- You will be delivering Bild's contemporary PBS programmes at different levels to direct support staff, practice leaders and senior leaders.
- We also offer service reviews and consultancy.
- As with all Bild employees, we expect our associates to be committed to co-production with people with lived experience.
- Associates should be interested in contributing to the development of PBS practice in the UK and internationally.
- Bild's programmes are delivered in-person and through blended online learning, and so you will be confident working both in-person and online.
- You will need to commit to a minimum of 10 days working and be able to travel.

You will participate in a thorough induction after which you will be welcomed into a team of associates, led by Professor Edwin Jones and Sarah Leitch, with ongoing access to CPD opportunities and support from the leads and your peers. You will need to attend bi-monthly associate meetings and will have the support of lead tutors and a buddy group.
