Job Purpose

To support the development of best practice workforce development in health services with a particular focus on Positive Behaviour Support, Trauma informed Practice, Active Support and Practice Leadership.

This role will report to Bild's Development Director.

Responsibilities

Delivery work (approx. 1/4 to 1/3 of role)

- Leading projects delivered in health services
- Leading projects that support trauma informed practice
- Delivering practice leader and senior leader level training
- Providing clinical advice to projects
- Lead tutor for Trauma qualifications

Development work

- Develop good relationships with and be the main point of contact for health customers
- Recruit, develop, and support a team of health workforce development associate consultants so there is capacity to deliver commissioned programmes and projects
- Work with Development Director to adapt the Workforce Development Framework and programmes for health
- Oversee the development of trauma informed workforce development programmes
- Support health stream for Bild and RRN conferences

- Effectively use Bild systems (e.g. Salesforce CRM) and attend internal meetings as required
