What is coproduction?



Coproduction means professionals working with people with lived experience to do or change something.



By professional we mean anyone who works with someone with lived experience. This could be a doctor, a social worker, a manager, an office worker, or a support worker.



At Bild we prefer to use the words 'working together' when we talk about coproduction, as these are simpler words and not jargon.
